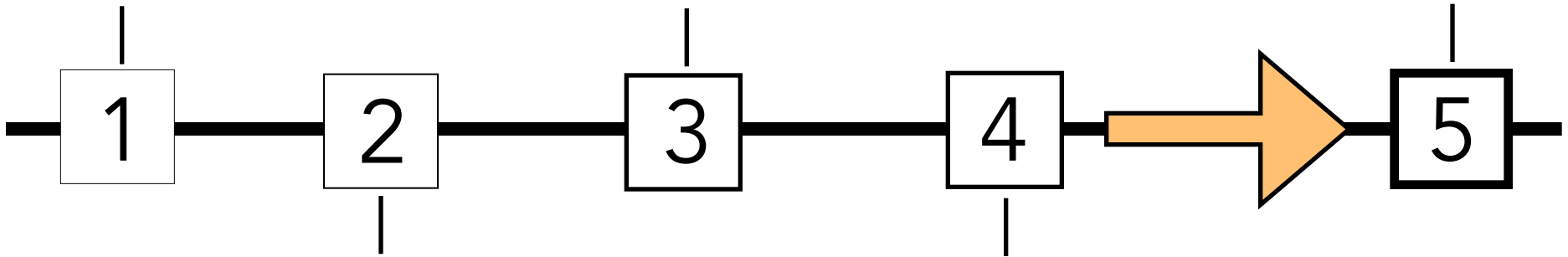


# TAKE DOWN TARGET

- Only the Community Organizer and/or Data Guru have seen or been involved in determining the community's Take Down Targets
- Non-existent community buy-in

- A wide variety of community stakeholders have seen the community's draft Take Down Targets and there is strong consensus among the group
- Community relies on draft Take Down Target proposed by Gap Analysis Tool rather than augmenting it with local data

- A wide variety of community stakeholders have seen or been involved in determining the community's Take Down Targets and there is strong consensus among the group
- Community has submitted local data to refine the standard chronic multiplier AND has replaced 2014 PIT with 2015 PIT or a by-name list
- Community understands how Take Down Target translates into monthly housing placement targets
- Community understands the ways in which their Take Down Targets can be further refined if not already done so -- i.e. replacing PIT data with a by-name list AND has committed to working toward that goal



- A variety of community stakeholders have seen or been involved in determining the community's Take Down Targets but there is very little consensus among the group
- Few, if any, stakeholders have embraced and taken ownership over Take Down Targets

- A wide variety of community stakeholders have seen or been involved in determining the community's draft Take Down Targets and there is strong consensus among the group
- Community has submitted local data to refine the standard multiplier
- Community has replaced 2014 PIT with 2015 PIT or a by-name list
