

Candid is a nonprofit that helps other nonprofits serve their communities. The Forefront Library offers Candid's key tools including GuideStar and Foundation Directory (FDO). Our members can access GuideStar to research local nonprofits to support and to find services. Nonprofits seeking funding can also access Foundation Directory to find and connect with funders

- Claim and update your Nonprofit profile


Foundation Directory helps nonprofits find funding faster



 - Do I know anybody associated with this funder?



Unsolicited pre-applications are accepted for: Community Services and Jewish Community in Cook County and/or Lake County. Pre-applications are not accepted for Medical Research If your application is accepted, expect an email to set up a phone call or site visit to learn more about your organization and the program for which you are requesting funding

Application form required.

Applicants should submit the following:

- 1. Listing of additional sources and amount of support
- 2. Copy of current year's organizational budget and/or project budget
- Listing of board of directors, trustees, officers and other key people and their affiliations
- 4. Brief history of organization and description of its mission
- 5. Results expected from proposed grant
